



## Total Retention in Further Post-Secondary Education, Training, or Employment Single Parents and Displaced Homemakers (2003-2004)

*In many States, displaced homemakers and single parents enrolled in career and technical education programs met or exceeded target performance levels for total retention in further post-secondary education, training, or employment during the 2003 -2004 school year. ±*

± Under the Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Technical Education Act of 1998, States were required to report performance data on four core accountability indicators. The third core indicator measures placement and retention in further education, training, or employment. For the post-secondary level, this indicator is divided into two sub-indicators: 1.) placement in further education, training, or employment, and 2.) retention in further education, training, or employment. The sub-indicator on retention measures the percentage of post-secondary graduates of vocational education programs that transitioned to and continued in programs of education, training, employment, or military service for a defined time period.
